

RESOLUTION 85- 127

WHEREAS Florida Statute 161.58(2) provides that local government, by a three-fifths vote of its governing body, may authorize vehicular traffic on all or portions of the coastal beaches under its jurisdiction.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY THIS 24 DAY OF September 1985.


1. All St. Johns County resolutions and ordinances pertaining to vehicles on the coastal beaches within the unincorporated areas of St. Johns County that are in effect on the date of this resolution shall remain in effect until amended or rescinded by this Board.

2. Subject to the restrictions and regulations imposed by the resolutions and ordinances described in paragraph #1 above, vehicular traffic is authorized on the coastal beaches within the unincorporated areas of St. Johns County.

3. This resolution may be amended by future resolutions and/or ordinances of St. Johns County to prohibit or further restrict vehicular traffic on all or portions of the coastal beaches located within the unincorporated areas of St. Johns County.
