

RESOLUTION NO. 85-187

AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION TO AMEND SECTION 4 AND SECTION 7 OF RESOLUTION 85-156 RELATING TO A GRANT FOR BUTLER BEACH PHASE III, AS REQUESTED BY THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, OFFICE OF RECREATION SERVICES, CORRESPONDENCE DATED DECEMBER 6, 1985.

WHEREAS, the Department of Natural Resources, Office of Recreation Services has requested additional certifications of Resolution 85-156 which authorized submission of a Grant Application addressing Butler Beach Phase III under the Florida Recreation Development Assistance Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and certified by the Chairman and the Board of County Commissioners, St. Johns County, Florida, that the following sections of Resolution 85-156 be changed to read;

4. That the amount of matching funds required \$20, 863.00 is available, is hereby appropriated and will remain available for the life of the grant from County Recreational Funds in the form of cash, in kind services, equipment rental and/or in house labor.

7.1 That the County of St. Johns has an officially adopted Local Comprehensive Plan which includes a Recreation and Open Space Element.

7.2 That the County of St. Johns certifies that with the completion of this site, it will have taken a positive step toward its goal of providing beach access and passive recreation facilities to the local inhabitants of this and other Counties of the State of Florida and its many out of state visitors.
