

RESOLUTION NO. 85-30

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA OF INTENT TO APPLY FOR A COASTAL ZONE MANAGEMENT GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, our local government is eligible for federal coastal management funds (Section 306, Federal Coastal Zone Management Act) through application to the Department of Environmental Regulations.

WHEREAS, priority will be given to projects dealing with protection and management of natural coastal resources, management of coastal development, improved public access to coastal areas, and improved predictability and efficiency of government decision making,

WHEREAS, St. Johns County needs to study and evaluate and implement 1) beach access and parking, 2) tourism and recreational needs, 3) an emergency management ordinance for residents along the ocean to be a legal and binding commitment for permitting of beach stabilization prior to or after severe weather,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that a grant application be made to the Department of Environmental Regulations for a Coastal Zone Management Grant Application.
