

RESOLUTION NO. 85-55


BE IT RESOLVED, THIS 9th DAY OF APRIL, 1985, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

The Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County hereby directs the following proposition to be placed on the ballot at the election concerning placing an additional ad valorem tax of one mill for one year for the purchase of Rattlesnake Island:


