

RESOLUTION NO. 86-129

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Tax Collector Dennis W. Hollingsworth has requested written permission from the Board of County Commissioners for extending the services of his office to the northwest section of St. Johns County at the Courthouse Annex, which is being renovated for use until a permanent facility is built; and,

WHEREAS, the Board concurs that such extension of services is a purpose for which the Annex is being established, and will be of benefit and in the best interests of the citizens of St. Johns County, and will help to relieve that congestion and traffic and parking space problems at the main Courthouse;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida;

That the Board grants the permission requested and endorses the extension of services of the St. Johns County Tax Collector's Office to the new Courthouse Annex, upon its completion, in the northwest section of St. Johns County.

That the Tax Collector, the Clerk of Courts and all other Constitutional Officers are hereby advised that the Courthouse Annex is not located in the County Seat and that no instrument shall be deemed recorded in the county until filed at the County Seat according to law.

The Clerk is requested and instructed to deliver a copy of this resolution to each Constitutional officer of St. Johns County.
