

RESOLUTION NO. 86-92

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING COUNTY RESOLUTION 86-72 WHICH IS THE RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM FEE AUTHORIZED BY ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 86-55 AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on June 24, 1986, the Board of County Commissioners for St. Johns County adopted St. Johns County Resolution Number 86-72, establishing August 1, 1986 and February 1, 1988 as the beginning and ending dates respectfully, for the collection of the emergency telephone system fee established by said resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has been advised that the telephone companies are unable to start collecting the fee on August 1, 1986 as anticipated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA as follows:

Section 2 of St. Johns County Resolution 86-72 is deleted and the following is added and substituted in its stead.

Section 2. Effective Date and Termination Date. The fee provided for by St. Johns County Resolution 86-72 shall be collected by all telephone companies operating in St. Johns County beginning no later than October 1, 1986 and continuing for a period of eighteen (18) months and shall terminate no later than April 1, 1988.
