

RESOLUTION 87- 100

WHEREAS, ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA HAS OWNED AND MAINTAINED COUNTY ROAD 210 FOR THE PAST SEVERAL YEARS, AND

WHEREAS, TRAFFIC ON THE SUBJECT ROAD HAS INCREASED TO THE LEVEL WHERE THE ROAD IS NOW A CANDIDATE TO BE RETURNED TO D.O.T. JURISDICTION, AND

WHEREAS, THE STATE REVIEW OF THE ROAD MUST BE COMPLETED BY JULY 1987, OR WAIT AN ADDITIONAL TWO YEARS, AND

WHEREAS, MEASUREMENTS OF EXISTING TRAFFIC COUNTS ON THE SUBJECT ROAD ARE REQUIRED PRIOR TO CONSIDERATION BY THE STATE, AND

WHEREAS, EXISTING TRAFFIC COUNTERS DO NOT MEET STATE CRITERIA AND COUNTERS TO MEET STATE REQUIREMENTS ARE AVAILABLE FROM ONLY ONE KNOWN SUPPLIER

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY FLORIDA THAT THE BOARD DECLARES AN EMERGENCY EXISTS, AND AUTHORIZES THE SETTING ASIDE OF THE REQUIREMENTS FOR BIDDING, AND AUTHORIZES THE PURCHASE OF FOUR TRAFFIC COUNTERS AT A PRICE NOT TO EXCEED \$6,500 FOR THE COUNTERS AND \$1,500 FOR ACCESSORIES. ALL COUNTERS AND ACCESSORIES SHALL BE SUITABLE FOR USE IN THE FEDERALLY FUNDED SAFETY PROGRAM APPROVED FOR OCTOBER 1987.

SAID COUNTERS AND ACCESSORIES ARE NEEDED TO ALLEVIATE THE EXISTING EMERGENCY AND CANNOT BE OBTAINED IN SUFFICIENT TIME IF BIDS, PUBLIC NOTICE AND ADVERTIZEMENT ARE REQUIRED. FURTHER SUCH ITEMS ARE AVAILABLE TO THE COUNTY FROM A SOLE SOURCE.
