

RESOLUTION NO. 87-112

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA PROVIDING FOR THE PAVING OF A PORTION OF AGRICULTURE CENTER DRIVE UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE 76-21 AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, has received and accepted the petition of at least 75% of the landowners fronting on Agriculture Center Drive, to have that road paved pursuant to County Ordinance 76-21 as amended.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida as follows:

1. The petition is hereby accepted and the project is authorized to commence.
2. The beginning and ending points of the portion of Agriculture Center Drive to be paved are Station 30+00 extending 2,600 feet to Station 56+00.
3. The cost of the project shall not exceed \$111,000.
4. The petitioner, Charles R. Usina, shall pay 100% of the cost of the paving.
5. The interest rate shall be 9.0 percent per annum.
6. The term of payment shall be five years with 20% plus interest due each annual payment.
7. Payments shall commence with the ad valorem tax bill due April 1, 1988, as mailed on or about November 1, 1987.
