

RESOLUTION 87- 157

WHEREAS, it is known that one (1) Ton Cab/Chassis's are only produced at one time per year with that being in June and that it would be approximately ten (10) months before a new one is available; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Manual dated 5-86, as adopted by the Board of County Commissioners, authorizing immediate procurement (Section 1 Para. III B) to protect the life, health, and public safety of the public, and that the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners was verbally notified by the County Administrator as required by the manual.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida that the Board declares that an emergency does exist and authorizes the setting aside of the requirements for bidding, and authorize the purchase of a 1987 one (1) Ton Chevrolet Cab/Chassis for St. Johns County Rescue at the price of \$14,053.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the equipment is needed to alleviate the need for said equipment and could not be obtained in sufficient time if Bids, Public Notice and Advertisement were required. Jack Wilson Chevrolet was the only local company available to the county having said equipment available immediately.
