

RESOLUTION NO. 89-273

WHEREAS, an un-named timber bridge on Leonard Rd. over a drainage canal in the Hastings area, has been inspected and declared unsafe for heavy traffic; and

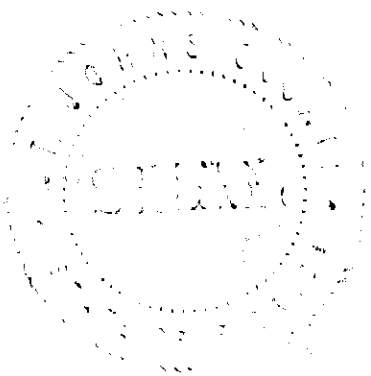
WHEREAS, this bridge has been in continual use by businesses and residents for many years; and

WHEREAS, replacement of this bridge is considered the most economical means of repair of the existing substandard conditions; and

WHEREAS, this Board finds in accordance with Chapter 81-483 2(e) Laws of Florida that procurement of a replacement bridge is needed to alleviate an existing unsafe condition constituting an emergency and such procurement can not be obtained in sufficient time if new engineering designs, public notice and advertisement, and construction bids are required.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that speedy replacement of the Leonard Rd. Bridge is declared a matter of public welfare and need, an emergency requiring suspension of normal bidding requirements, and that the County Public Works Department is directed to proceed posthaste with the procurement of a replacement.
