

RESOLUTION NO. 90-127

WHEREAS, St. Johns County has received a request from Community Service Advertising for the placement of school bus stop shelters to be located within the County right-of-way along certain designated school bus stops. (As designated by the St. Johns County School Board or as designated from time to time.)

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners hereby grants to Community Service Advertising the right to place school bus stop shelters within the County right-of-way at various locations to be installed by Community Service Advertising subject to the following conditions:

1. This right of use is non-exclusive and is not transferable by Community Service Advertising in any way, shape or form.

2. Community Service Advertising shall remove or relocate any structures at their expense, upon request of the County, for any reason, at anytime in the future.

3. The structures located within County right-of-way must be privately maintained by Community Service Advertising at all times. St. Johns County will assume no responsibility for maintenance of this use.

4. Any signage shall conform to the St. Johns County Sign Ordinance and this resolution does not give or grant to Community Service Advertising any variance or waiver from strict compliance with the sign ordinance except as to the ability to have signage within the right-of-way on the school bus stop shelters only.

5. Community Service Advertising shall carry liability insurance on the structures listing St. Johns County as an insured party in the minimum amount of \$100,000 per person and \$200,000 per occurrence and shall provide proof of continued compliance with this provision to the St. Johns County Clerk of Courts.

6. Prior to installation of any shelters, Community Service Advertising will apply for and receive a building permit from St. Johns County for each type and model of building structure to be used in the unincorporated area of St. Johns County and shall comply with all City Building ordinances for structures located within the City or Town.

7. Community Service Advertising will locate the school bus stop shelters no less than 10 feet from the edge of any thoroughfare subject to F.D.O.T Clear Zone Standards

and evaluated by the County Engineer, and will do so in a manner that does not obstruct any field of vision from any adjacent roads, driveways or thoroughfares whether paved or unpaved.

8. Community Service Advertising will comply with all applicable County requirements including all building department codes and regulations.

9. Community Service Advertising will comply with all applicable Department of Transportation requirements.

10. Community Service Advertising by acceptance of these conditions and locating the school bus stop shelters within the right-of-way, agrees to assume all liability for the location, installation and safety of the structures for as long as they remain on County property.

11. The School Board of St. Johns County or its designee shall approve the location of each school bus stop shelter prior to its installation.
