NOTICE OF AIRPORT REFERENDUM TO BE HELD IN
ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA
ON NOVEMBER 6, 1990

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT A REFERENDUM PERTAINING TO THE ST. AUGUSTINE AND ST. JOHNS COUNTY AIRPORT will be held on the 6th day of November, 1990, in St. Johns County, Florida, whereby the electors of St. Johns County may vote on whether or not the St. Augustine and St. Johns County Airport Authority should remain an independent authority with elected members accountable to the voters of St. Johns County.

The places for voting in the Airport referendum shall be the same as the places for voting in general elections held in St. Johns County, and the polls will be open at the voting places on the date of said referendum from 7:00 A.M. until 7:00 P.M.

All qualified electors residing within St. Johns County shall be entitled, qualified and permitted to vote at such referendum.
