

THIS RESOLUTION authorizes the County Administrator to submit an application for an Artificial Fishing Reef Grant to the Florida Department of Natural Resources, Division of Marine Resources; certifies that the County of St. Johns is eligible to receive the grant as a Governmental Entity; confirms that the County of St. Johns is fiscally able and legally responsible to administer the building of the artificial reef; and hereby certifies that the facility will be open to any and all segments of the public:

WHEREAS, the County of St. Johns has prepared a grant application for the expansion of an existing Artificial Fishing Reef under the Division of Marine Resources; and,

WHEREAS, it is required that a Resolution be adopted and become an official part of the application; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners, County of St. Johns, Florida, as follows:

1. That the County of St. Johns is hereby requesting the above described grant funds in the amount of \$25,000.
2. That the County Administrator is hereby authorized to apply for the funds from the Division of Marine Resources.
3. The County of St. Johns recognizes the recreational contribution of an Artificial Ocean Fishing Reef to the local public as well as out of state visitor.
4. That there have and will be interested citizens and Governmental employees continually interested in advertising and promoting the use of this Artificial Fishing Reef.
5. St. Johns County is eligible to receive the grant as a Governmental Entity.
6. St. Johns County is fiscally able and legally responsible to administer the building of the Artificial Reef and hereby certifies that the facility will be open to any and all segments of the public.
