

RESOLUTION NO. 90- 39

A RESOLUTION PASSED PURSUANT TO ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 88-18 INCREASING THE NUMBER OF "NO VEHICLE TRAFFIC ZONES" ON THE ATLANTIC OCEAN BEACH FROM THREE TO FIVE.

Whereas Section 4 Paragraph B of St. Johns County Ordinance No. 88-18 establishes the number and maximum length of no vehicle traffic zones on the Atlantic Ocean Beaches located within the unincorporated areas of St. Johns County, Florida; and

Whereas said ordinance provides that the maximum number and the maximum length of "no Vehicle traffic" zones may be changed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED this 27th day of February, 1990 by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, as follows:

Section 1. The Sheriff of St. Johns County and his designees may designate and establish from time to time one or more (not to exceed 5 in number at any given time) "no Vehicle traffic zones" on the Atlantic Ocean Beach, up to 1 mile in length each, within which Vehicles are prohibited from driving or parking.

Section 2. The terms "Vehicle" and "Atlantic Ocean Beach" shall have the meanings set forth in St. Johns County ordinance #88-18.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
