

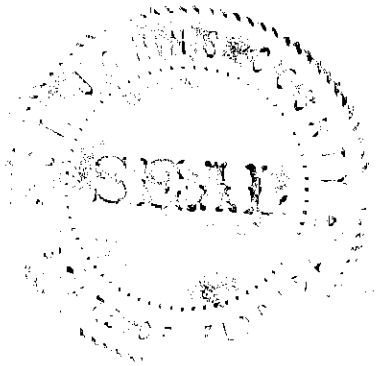
RESOLUTION NO. 90-70


Legal description as per attached SCHEDULE "A"

and the notice concerning such hearing required by St. Johns County is hereby authorized and directed to be published.



All that part of the following described lands lying along the West line of the East half of the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section 30, Township 7 South, Range 29 East being projected Southerly across Lot 1, Section 31-7-29 to the North right-of-way line of County Road 214.

Easement for a water supply line "Transmission Pipe Line" along an existing 30 foot wide road right-of-way in St. Johns County, Florida whose West edge is described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 30, Township 7 South, Range 29 East, thence run South along the West edge of the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of said Section 30, being the Western edge of a haul road 30 feet in width a distance of 1320 feet, more or less, to the Southwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter; thence run East along the Southerly edge of a haul road located immediately North of and adjacent to the North line of the West half of the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter, to the West edge of the East half of the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of said Section 30; thence run South in a straight line along the West edge of a haul road located immediately East and adjacent to the West line of the East half of the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of said Section 30 (and projected and continued Southerly in a straight line across Government Lot 1 of Section 31, Township 7 South, Range 29 East, to its intersection with County Road 214.

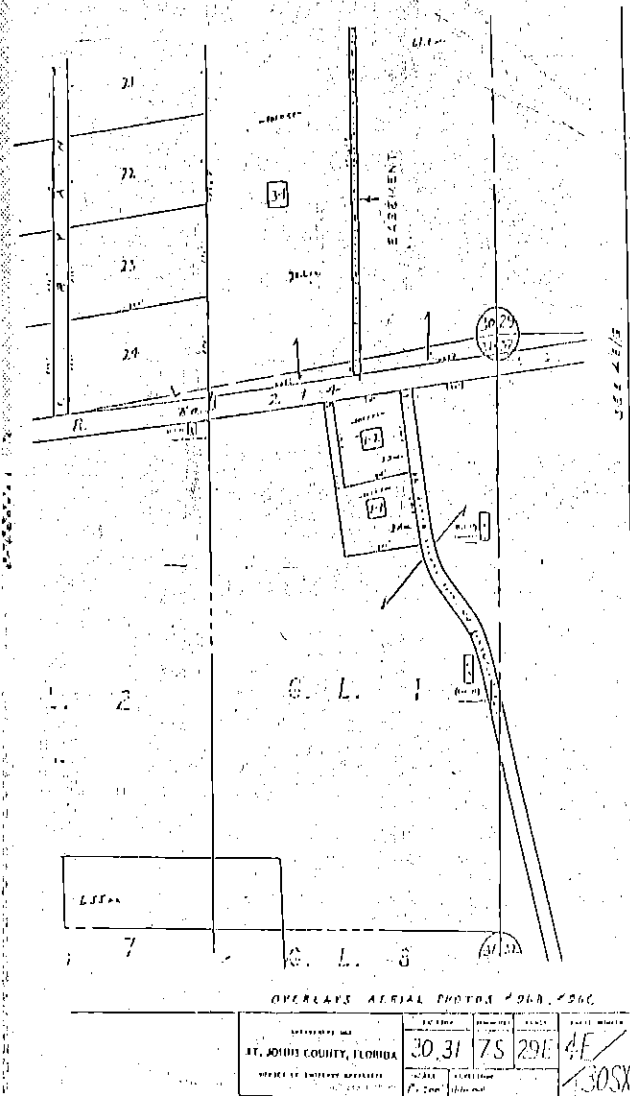
