

RESOLUTION NO. 91- 58

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A DRAFT BILL AMENDING s. 245.06 F.S; PROVIDING FOR CREMATION AS AN ALTERNATIVE TO EMBALMING AND BURIAL OF CERTAIN UNCLAIMED BODIES; REQUIRING CERTAIN RECORDS TO BE MAINTAINED; PROVIDING EXCEPTIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County is a growing County with many economic related problems, and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County is in need of finding a financially feasible solution to its handling of unclaimed dead bodies, and

WHEREAS, cremation is an alternative to a more expensive procedure of embalming and burial,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners are in support of the proposed draft HB 689 amending section 245.06 Florida Statutes providing for cremation as an alternative to embalming and burial of certain unclaimed dead bodies.
