

RESOLUTION NO. 92- 13

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES TO BE FOLLOWED IN MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR RESTATING BOARD MEMBERS' MOTIONS PRIOR TO VOTES THEREON.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, ("Board") desires to establish procedures for restating Board members' motions prior to votes on the motions made in County Commission meetings; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners has requested that the procedure be established by resolution to insure consistency;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. At his discretion, the Chairman of the Board may, prior to calling for a vote on any motion by a Board member, request the Deputy Clerk recording the minutes of the Board meeting to restate the motion as it appears in the Deputy Clerk's notes. If the motion has been amended prior to the request, the Deputy Clerk shall restate the original motion and each amendment thereto.

Section 2. The Deputy Clerk shall not be responsible for restating the motion unless requested to do so by the Chairman of the Board.

Section 3. After the Deputy Clerk has restated the motion and all amendments, if any, as set forth above in

section 1, the Board member who had made the motion must either (i) agree that the Deputy Clerk has properly restated the motion, as amended, by saying "so moved" or by using similar language to indicate that the motion was properly restated or (ii) must restate the motion, as amended if applicable, in language satisfactory to said Board member. In the event the Board member restates the motion and amendments, if applicable, the Board member's restatement shall control over the restatement expressed by the Deputy Clerk. The Board acknowledges that the Deputy Clerk shall not be held responsible for the correct restating of the motion prior to the vote.

Section 4. Regardless of any discrepancy between the original motion and original amendments, if any, and the motion and amendments restated pursuant to section 3 above, the restated motion and amendments, if any, shall control.

Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
