

RESOLUTION NO. 92-9

RESOLUTION SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING ON PETITION
TO VACATE A PORTION OF SIXTH AVENUE
WITHIN DE LEON MANORS SUBDIVISION

RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, in the County Auditorium of the St. Johns County Administration Building, on February 25, 1992, at 1:30 o'clock p.m., upon petition of qualified land owners, will consider the advisability of exercising the power granted to it by Section 336.09, Florida Statutes 1985, and determine whether it will vacate, abandon, discontinue and close portions of certain streets, alleyways or roads described as follows:

That certain portion of Sixth Avenue having a right-of-way of fifty feet (50'), bounded on the north by the right-of-way of Ocean Boulevard and on the south by lands owned by and known as the Ponce de Leon Resort and Convention Center, Inc.

The above described portion of Sixth Avenue being located within DeLeon Manors, as per plat recorded in Map Book 8, Page 80; being a resubdivision of Blocks 10, 17 and 18 of Jackson Park, a subdivision recorded in Map Book 3, Page 51, all of the public records of St. Johns County, Florida.

and the notice required by Section 336.10, Florida Statutes 1985, is hereby authorized and directed to be published.

Further, notice of the time, date and place of the public hearing shall be promptly mailed by certified mail-return receipt requested, to each of the persons and entities at their addresses as described in the title opinion letter attached to said petition, at least two (2) weeks prior to the hearing.

The petitioner shall perform such mailings and shall provide the Clerk with proof of same five (5) days before the scheduled hearing date.
