

RESOLUTION NO. 93-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA THAT SETS A LATE FEE FOR DELAYED CONTRACTOR CERTIFICATE RENEWALS AND REQUIRES COUNTY NOTIFICATION TO HOLDERS OF CERTAIN EXPIRED CONTRACTOR'S CERTIFICATES.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA that the late fee referred to in Paragraph G of Section VII of St. Johns County ordinance no. 76-20 as amended is hereby established and set at \$100.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Administrator or his designee is hereby directed to mail a notice by certified mail to each person whose certificate expires under the provisions of St. Johns County ordinance 76-20, as amended, notifying such person of the date that the grace period to renew such certificate will expire. Such notice shall be mailed not less than 180 days nor more than 210 days prior to the grace period expiration date and shall be mailed to the most recent address that is in the holder's certificate application file maintained by the County building department. Failure to mail or receive such notice shall not extend the grace period. The notice need not be sent to the holders of certificates that expired prior to September 30, 1992.
