

RESOLUTION NO. 93-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, GRANTING THE PONTE VEDRA PALM VALLEY BRANCH LIBRARY SPACE IN THE COURTHOUSE ANNEX TO THE OFFICE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY SHERIFF, UPON VACANCY.

WHEREAS, the new Ponte Vedra Library will be open in the next several months; and,

WHEREAS, the Sheriff of St. Johns County needs to make concrete plans in preparation for equipping and staffing a field office in that area; and,

WHEREAS, the majority of the citizens in the northeast sector have clearly expressed their desire for a field office in this location; and,

WHEREAS, a field office in this location could better serve the citizens in the northeast sector and could provide for better efficiency in law enforcement to serve the growing population in that area; and,

WHEREAS, the northeast sector of St. Johns County has experienced the fastest growth rate in the County and it appears this trend will continue into the future; and,

WHEREAS, it is sound planning to bring law enforcement closer to the major population areas in our county where the growth pattern is anticipated; and,

WHEREAS, the implementation of a field office in the northeast sector could enhance¹ the health, safety, and welfare of our citizens in this area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners that upon the vacancy of the Branch Library in the Ponte Vedra Palm Valley Courthouse Annex now occupied by the St. Johns County Library system, the Sheriff of St. Johns County shall be allowed the use of said space for use at his discretion in order to provide more efficient, responsive law enforcement to the citizens of northeast St. Johns County.
