A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA PROCLAIMING THE MONTH OF MARCH AS "AMERICAN WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH"
