

RESOLUTION NO. 94-151

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA ESTABLISHING THE ANNUAL SUMMER BEACH SEASON AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Ordinance No. 90-6 establishes the days and times for which beach fees are to be charged for driving on the Atlantic Ocean Beaches in the unincorporated areas of St. Johns County, such times and days hereinafter referred to as the summer beach season; and

WHEREAS, such Section 2 provides that such times and dates may be modified by resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County; and

WHEREAS, revenues collected past the Labor Day Weekend are insufficient to pay the actual operating cost; and

WHEREAS, considerable savings could be affected by ending the summer beach season after the Labor Day Weekend.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida as follows:

Section 1. The days and times for enforcement and the levy of the fees set forth in Sections 2 and 3 of St. Johns County Ordinance 90-6 shall commence each year on March 1 and shall continue daily through Labor Day Weekend. The time during such days shall be between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. The Beach Master is hereby authorized to determine, based on weather conditions, whether or not fees are to be collected on any given day during the summer beach season.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
