

RESOLUTION NO. 94- 159

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY,  
FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE REIMBURSEMENT  
OF TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUNDS FOR THE  
DEEP CREEK REVITALIZATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida passed Ordinance No. 94-16 (St. Johns County Stormwater Management Utility) on April 26, 1994, and became effective May 9, 1994; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County will work with the Town of Hastings and the St. Johns River Water Management District to solve a problem associated with the Deep Creek water basin; and

WHEREAS, much planning, engineering design and permitting is required for this is multiple phase project; and

WHEREAS, the first phase of this project is anticipated to be \$73,675 with Near Coastal Water Funding \$20,000 worth of this project; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County is using Transportation Trust Fund dollars to fund its share of the first phase of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

Section 1. The first phase of the Deep Creek Revitalization project will be funded from the Transportation Trust Fund with the understanding that when the Stormwater Management Utility non ad-valorem assessment revenues are received, the Transportation Trust Fund will be reimbursed for costs incurred for phase one of the Deep Creek Revitalization Project from such revenues. This is a duly authorized expense of Stormwater Management Utility.

Section 2. This resolution shall not require the County to participate in future phases of the project.
