

RESOLUTION 94-204

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 89-52 AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED BY ORDINANCE 93-39. THIS RESOLUTION MODIFIES THE AMOUNT OF MONEY RECEIVED PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTE SECTION 318.21(2)(g)2 THAT WILL BE USED TO FUND THE COUNTY'S CRIMINAL JUSTICE TRAINING PROGRAM AND THE COUNTY'S SCHOOL CROSSING GUARDS PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Ordinance 93-39 amended Ordinance 89-52 as previously amended modifying the amounts of money received pursuant to Florida Statute Section 318.21(2)(g)2 that are to be used to fund the County's Criminal Justice Training Program and the County's School Crossing Guard Program; and

WHEREAS, the apportioned amounts needed to adequately fund the County's Criminal Justice Training Program and the County's School Crossing Guard Program need to be adjusted; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Ordinance 93-39 amended Ordinance 89-52, Section 7, to allow future modifications to the percentage allocations set forth in Section 5 of Ordinance 89-52 to be made by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Ordinance 89-52 as previously amended be hereby amended by deleting the existing Section 5 and adding the following in its stead:

Section 5. Monies paid to St. Johns County pursuant to subparagraph (2)(g)2 of Florida Statutes Section 318.21 shall be apportioned and used in the following manner:

35% shall be used to help fund the St. Johns County Criminal Justice Training Program.

25% shall be used to help fund the St. Johns County School Crossing Guard Program.

40% shall be deposited into the General Fund of St. Johns County to be used for any lawful purpose.
