

RESOLUTION NO. 94- 52

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY PROCLAIMING APRIL 23, 1994 AS ST. JOHNS COUNTY CLEAN UP DAY IN CONJUNCTION WITH EARTH DAY.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of St. Johns County to encourage an attractive and litter free environment; and

WHEREAS, there exists within the unincorporated areas of the County, a littering of trash that disgraces the beauty of our county highways and other main arteries; and

WHEREAS, this littering is a blight to our community; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Legislature through the Solid Waste Management Act of 1988 has encouraged the implementation of litter removal programs on public roads; and

WHEREAS, there was created within the Department of Environmental Protection, the Clean Florida Commission, which is responsible for coordinating a statewide litter prevention program involving local governments; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Solid Waste Department proposes to organize a litter clean up on designated county roads by county employees and elected officials on April 23, 1994; and

WHEREAS, Browning Ferris Inc. and Seaboard Sanitation, the franchised trash haulers in St. Johns County, have agreed to assume the cost of safety vests and trash bags; and

WHEREAS, the franchisees have also agreed to collect at no charge, the bags of litter which will be placed at roadsides;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida that April 23, 1994 be declared St. Johns County Clean Up Day.
