

RESOLUTION NO. 95 - 209

RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, in the County Auditorium of St. Johns County Administration Building, on January 9, 1996, at 1:30 P.M. upon petition of qualified land owners, will consider the advisability of exercising the power granted to it by Section 336.90, Florida Statutes 1985, and determine whether it will vacate, abandon, discontinue and close portions of certain streets, alleyways or roads described as follows:

All that part of Ash Street being bounded as follows:

On the North by the Southerly right-of-way line of County Road 214; on the South by the Northerly right-of-way line of Kent Avenue; on the East by the Westerly boundary lines of Lots 1 through 10, Block 3; and on the West by the Easterly boundary lines of Lots 1 through 10, Block 1; and, on the North by the Southerly right-of-way line of Kent Avenue; on the South by the Northerly right-of-way line of Ohio Avenue; on the east by the Westerly boundary lines of Lots 1 through 11, Block 4; on the West by the Easterly boundary lines of Lots 1 through 11, Block 2, all lying in TOCOI, UNIT NO. 1, according to map of plat thereof recorded in Map Book 3, page 63, public records of St. Johns County, Florida.

and the notice required by Section 336.10, Florida Statutes 1985, is hereby authorized and directed to be published.

Further, notice of the time, date, and place of the public hearing shall be promptly mailed by certified mail - return receipt requested, to each of the persons and entities at their addresses as described in the North Florida Title Company search attached to the petition to vacate.

The petitioner shall perform such mailings and shall provide the Clerk with proof of same five days before the scheduled hearing date.
