

RESOLUTION 95-58

RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, SUPERSEDING RESOLUTION 93-62 BY ABOLISHING THE STATE HOUSING INITIATIVES PARTNERSHIP (SHIP) PROGRAM AFFORDABLE HOUSING ADVISORY COMMITTEE (AHAC), CREATED BY STATUTE FOR TWO YEARS, AND OFFERING PUBLIC APPRECIATION FOR THOSE MEMBERS COMPLETING THEIR TERM.

WHEREAS, the Affordable Housing Advisory Committee was created by statute to advise the St. Johns County State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) on writing the Housing Incentive Plan to further affordable housing efforts; and

WHEREAS, the said Housing Incentive Plan was approved by the Florida Housing Finance Agency, state administrators of the SHIP program, on April 19, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Affordable Housing Advisory Committee was appointed to serve a two-year term, which expires on April 13, 1995; and

WHEREAS, deep appreciation is extended to all members of the AHAC for their voluntary service.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Affordable Housing Advisory Committee is hereby abolished by this Resolution, which supersedes Resolution 93-62.

SECTION 2. That all members serving on the Affordable Housing Advisory committee are hereby offered public appreciation by the Board of County Commissioners.
