

RESOLUTION 96 -103

RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF A CHARTER COMMISSION IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 125.60 FLORIDA STATUTES.

WHEREAS, a delegation of citizens has requested the appointment of a Charter Commission, and

WHEREAS, the Citizens Study Committee of 21 in its final report recommended the appointment of a Charter Commission, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds it in the best interest of the County to do so.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, as follows:

Section 1: A Charter Commission is hereby established pursuant to Section 125.60 through Section 125.64 Florida Statutes.

Section 2: The Charter Commission shall consist of eleven (11) members to be appointed by the Board of County Commissioners within thirty (30) days of the passage of this Resolution.

Section 3: The budget established for the Charter Commission shall be up to \$25,000 and the County Administrator is hereby authorized to provide such support and assistance as is appropriate for such items as meeting rooms, access to documents and records, telephone use and similar routine support.

Section 4: A line item budget shall be submitted to the Board of County Commissioners and the Clerk of Courts prior to the expending of any money.
