

RESOLUTION NO. 96- 20

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA AMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 89-52 AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED. THIS RESOLUTION MODIFIES THE APPORTIONMENT OF THE MONEY RECEIVED PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTE SECTION 318.21(2)(g)2 TO FUND THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY CRIMINAL JUSTICE TRAINING PROGRAM AND THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Resolution No. 94-204 amended Ordinance No. 89-52, as previously amended, modifying the apportionment of the monies received pursuant to Florida Statute Section 318.21(2)(g)2 to fund the County's Criminal Justice Training Program and the County's School Crossing Guard Program; and

WHEREAS, the apportioned amount needed to adequately fund the County's Criminal Justice Training Program and the School Crossing Guard Program needs to be adjusted;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Ordinance No. 89-52, as previously amended, be hereby amended by deleting the existing Section 5 and adding the following in its stead:

Section 5. Monies paid to St. Johns County pursuant to subparagraph (2)(g)2 of Florida Statutes Section 318.21 shall be apportioned and used in the following manner:

35% shall be deposited into the General Fund of St. Johns County to be used for any lawful purpose.

65% shall be used to fund the County School Crossing Guard Program with any remaining funds to be used for the County Criminal Justice Training Program.
