A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY DELEGATING AUTHORITY OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO RESPOND TO AND EXECUTE INTERROGATORIES DIRECTED TO ST. JOHNS COUNTY AS PART OF ADMINISTRATIVE OR JUDICIAL LITIGATION.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County that:

1. The County Administrator is authorized, with the advice of the Office of the County Attorney, or other legal counsel representing the County, to answer or respond to, and execute interrogatories submitted to the County as part of administrative or judicial litigation.
2. The County Administrator may, in his or her discretion, bring any particular interrogatory to the Board of County Commissioners for answer or response.
