

RESOLUTION NO. 98-136

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR AN ELECTION TO CONSIDER EXPANSION OF THE ANASTASIA MOSQUITO CONTROL DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Anastasia Mosquito Control District of St. Johns County has filed a petition requesting that an election be held of the registered voters residing in the District and the territory proposed to be added as described in the Description of Territory attached hereto;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, finds that the eradication or control of mosquitoes and other arthropods in the said territory is desired for the preservation of the public health, comfort and welfare of the inhabitants thereof, and further that it is feasible and practicable to eradicate or control mosquitoes and other arthropods in said territory;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. It is ordered that an election shall be held of the registered electors residing in the District and in the territory proposed to be added to the District, to determine by the majority of votes cast in said District, and by the majority of votes cast in said territory, whether said territory shall be added to the District. Both of said majority votes in favor of expansion of the District shall be necessary for expansion of the District. If either a majority of the votes cast in the District or a majority of the votes cast in the said territory proposed to be added to the District are not in favor of adding the territory, then the territory shall not be added to the District.

SECTION 2. The election shall be held on November 3, 1998.

SECTION 3. The Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners is directed to cause a notice of such election to be published once each week for four consecutive weeks, in the fifth week, fourth week, third week, and second week prior to the week in which the election is to be held, in a newspaper of general circulation published in St. Johns County, Florida, including in such notice a description of the territory proposed to be added to the District.

SECTION 4. The ballot title shall be:

PROPOSED EXPANSION OF THE BOUNDARIES OF THE ANASTASIA
MOSQUITO CONTROL DISTRICT OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY

SECTION 5. The wording of the ballot shall be substantially in conformity with the form attached hereto.

DESCRIPTION OF TERRITORY

Precinct 12

Beginning at the intersection of I-95 and State Road 16; thence southerly along I-95 to County Road 214; thence westerly along County Road 214 to Poa Boy Road; thence northerly along Poa Boy Road to Sawdust Road; thence westerly along Sawdust Road to County Road 13A; thence northerly along County Road 13A to the northerly line of census block 150; thence westerly along said line to the centerline of the powerlines which are 8000 feet west of County Road 13A; thence northerly along said powerlines to County Road 208; thence easterly along County Road 208 to County Road 16; thence easterly along County Road 16 to the point of beginning.

Precinct 22

Beginnng at the intersection of I-95 and County Road 210 West thence southwestery along County Road 210 West, to where a power station and poles are located just south of said road; thence southerly along said power poles to Road #1, thence westerly along Road #1 to where Road #1 intersects the southerly limits of Cenus Block #139; thence westerly along said block to where it intersects the westerly limit of census block #116, thence southwestery along said limit to where it intersects County Road 16A; thence northerly and westerly along County Road 16A to County Road 210 West; thence southerly along County Road 210 West to the intersection of State Road 13 North; thence south to County Road 16 to the centerline of the main channel of the St Johns River, also being the boundary between St Johns County and Clay County, thence southerly along the centerline to the westerly extension of the mouth of Six Mile Creek; thence easterly along said extension to Six Mile Creek and along the centerline thereof to where said creek intersects County Road 13 North, thence northerly along County Road 13 North to County Road 16, thence easterly along County Road 16 to westerly limit of Census Block #182; thence northerly along westerly limits of Block #182, #172, and #164 to Cummer Road; thence easterly along Cummer Road to I-95; thence northerly along I-95 to the point of beginning.

Precinct 33

Beginng at the intersection of the center of Six Mile Creek and County Road 13; thence southwestery along County Road 13 to the west line of census block 119; thence southerly along the west line of census block 119 to County Road 208; thence easterly along County Road 208 to Steven Colee Road; thence southerly and westerly along Steven Colee Road to the north-south powerlines which are 8000' west of County Road 13A; thence southerly along the powerlines to Tocoli Creek; thence westerly and southwestery along Tocoli Creek to its mouth thereof; thence due west to the west margin of the main channel of the St. Johns River; thence northerly along the main channel of the St. Johns River to apoint that is due west of Six Mile Creek; thence east to the mouth of Six Mile Creek; thence southeasterly along the center of Six Mile Creek to the point of beginning.

Precinct 34

Beginning at the intersection of Nine Mile Road and County Road 16, thence southeasterly along Country Road 16 to County Road 208, thence westerly along County Road 208 to the west line of census block 119; thence northerly along the west line of census block 119 to County Road 13, thence northeasterly along County Road 13 to State Road 16, thence east on State Road 16 to the point of beginning.

Precinct 45

Beginning at the intersection of County Road 16 and I-95; thence northerly and westerly along County Road 16 to the westerly limit of Census Block #182; thence northerly along westerly limits of Block #182, #172, and #164 to Cummer Road; thence easterly along Cummer Road to I-95, thence southerly along I-95 to the point of beginning.

Part of Precinct 53

THE PART OF PRECINCT 53 HEREAFTER DESCRIBED WHICH IS LOCATED TO THE SOUTH OF COUNTY ROAD 210 WEST:

Beginning at the intersection of State Road 13 North and Greenbriar Road; thence southeasterly along Greenbriar Road to County Road 210 West; thence east on County Road 210 West to where power station and poles are located just south of County Road 210 West; thence southerly along said power poles to Road #1; thence westerly along Road #1 to where Road #1 intersects the southerly limit of Census Block #139; thence westerly along said block to where it intersects the easterly limit of Census Block #116; thence southwesterly along said limit to where it intersects County Road 16A; thence westerly along County Road 16A to County Road 210 West; thence southerly along County Road 210 West to the intersection of State Road 13 North; thence south to County Road 16 to the centerline of the main channel of the St. Johns River, also being the boundary between St. Johns County and Clay County; thence northerly along said centerline to the westerly extension of the Greenbriar Road; thence easterly on Greenbriar to the point of beginning.

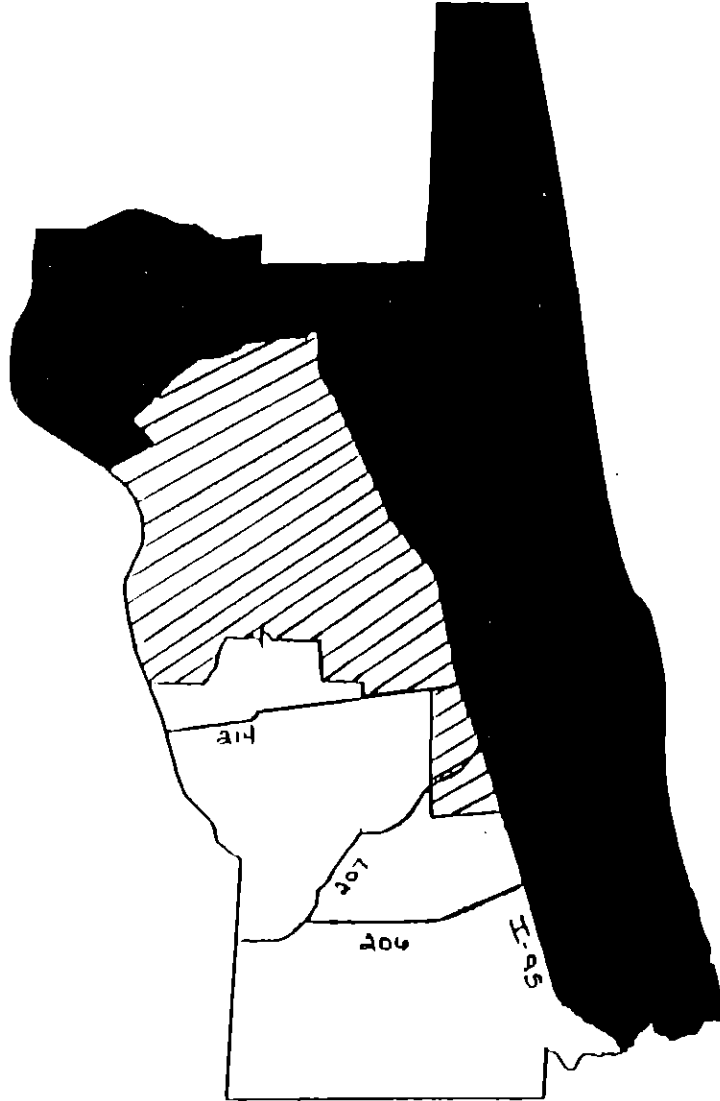
Part of Precinct 16

THE PART OF PRECINCT 16 DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:


That portion of Section 32 located to the west of I-95 in Township 7 South, Range 29 East; that portion of Section 33 located to the west of I-95 in Township 7 South, Range 29 East; that portion of Section 29 located to the south of County Road 214 in Township 7 South, Range 29 East; those portions of Sections 4, 9, 10, 15, and 22 which are located to the west of I-95 in Township 8 South, Range 29 East; and all of Sections 5, 8, 16, 17, 20, and 21 in Township 8 South, Range 29 East, in St. Johns County, Florida.

**PETITION TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY TO EXTEND THE BOUNDARIES
OF THE ANASTASIA MOSQUITO CONTROL DISTRICT**

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Anastasia Mosquito Control District of St. Johns County is vested with authority to petition the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County to request the calling of an election to determine whether the boundaries of the District shall be enlarged under Chapter 61-2745, Laws of Florida, and Chapter 388, Florida Statutes;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Anastasia Mosquito Control District of St. Johns County has determined that the eradication or control of mosquitoes and other arthropods in the territory described in the attached Description of Territory is desired for the preservation of the public health, comfort and welfare of the inhabitants thereof;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Anastasia Mosquito Control District of St. Johns County has determined that it is feasible and practicable to eradicate or control mosquitoes and other arthropods in the territory described in the attached Description of Territory.

NOW THEREFORE, it is respectfully requested that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, call an election of the registered electors residing within the existing District, and the registered electors residing within the territory proposed to be added to the existing District, to determine by the majority of votes cast in the existing District, and the majority of votes cast in the territory proposed to be added to the District, whether said territory

will be added to the District. Further, it is requested that such election be held as part of the general election in 1998.

This Petition was approved and passed by the Board of Commissioners of the Anastasia Mosquito Control District of St. Johns County on the 11th day of June, 1998.
