

RESOLUTION NO. 98-137

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADDRESSING THE COOPERATIVE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN ST. JOHNS AND DUVAL COUNTIES.

WHEREAS, the counties of St. Johns and Duval share a common border, river and coastline; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns and Duval counties share the major thoroughfares of Interstate 95; State Road 13, also known as the Bartram Scenic Highway; State Road A1A, also known as the Buccaneer Trail; and U.S. 1, along which an estimated 19,000 St. Johns County residents commute each day; and

WHEREAS, growth along the border of St. Johns and Duval counties is the highest area of growth in both counties; and

WHEREAS, to ensure seamless future growth management and minimum congestion of land and roads, it is imperative that St. Johns and Duval counties work in a cooperative effort with regard to planning, road improvements, resource management and other growth-related issues

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners and its staff will work with the Mayor, the Jacksonville City Council and its staff to communicate regularly and work toward a cooperative relationship for the benefit of the residents and visitors to St. Johns and Duval counties.
