

RESOLUTION 2000 - 79

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2000 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO RECEIVE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE AND AUTHORIZE ITS EXPENDITURE FOR THE ST. JOHNS RIVER PROJECT.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County has implemented the Watershed Action Volunteers Program, which conducts its operations through a General Fund budget know as the St. Johns River Project; and

WHEREAS, the County has annually received a grant of funds from the St. Johns River Water Management District to provide certain services related to the environment; and

WHEREAS, the County operating budget is appropriated annually without knowledge of the grants or the actual amount of grant funds which may be received by the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County, Florida, when preparing the budget for Fiscal Year 2000, did not anticipate receiving grant funds from the St. Johns River Water Management District above and beyond those projected; and

WHEREAS, the St. Johns River Water Management District has made available, through a cost sharing agreement, grant dollars to the County for the accomplishment of a volunteer – based environmental program which benefits the St. Johns River and other watershed areas; and

WHEREAS, the St. Johns River Water Management District will deliver its share of the current costs under the agreement for Fiscal Year 2000 in the amount of \$10,000.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

1. The above “Whereas” statements are adopted as a finding of fact.
2. The General Fund revenue and expenditure budgets shall be adjusted to account for unanticipated funds from the St. Johns River Water Management District in the amount of \$10,000 for Fiscal Year 1999-2000.
