

RESOLUTION 2001 - 112

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA DECLARING THE NAMING OF THE NEW NORTHEAST PARK TO BE IN CONFORMANCE WITH RESOLUTION NO. 99-152 REGARDING POLICY FOR THE NAMING OF PUBLIC FACILITIES. ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD. APPROVING THE PARK NAME AS "DAVIS PARK."

WHEREAS the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County established a policy for the naming of public facilities as Resolution 99-152; and,

WHEREAS the Davis Family donated the 138 acre park site for the enjoyment of the residents of St. Johns County; and,

WHEREAS Exhibit "A" of Resolution 99-152 (Item 6) states, "Donors of land and/or large sums of money will be considered in the naming of a resulting public facility or integral parts thereof, if possible. Donations should be sufficient to pay for acquisition or development or maintenance in perpetuity;" and,

WHEREAS the policy requires the recommendation of the Recreation Advisory Board; and,

WHEREAS the Recreation Advisory Board, at their April 11, 2001 meeting approved recommending the naming of this park "Davis Park;"

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA that the new northeast park is named "Davis Park".
