

RESOLUTION NO. 2001-193

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR AND HIS OR HER DESIGNEES TO RESPOND TO AND EXECUTE INTERROGATORIES DIRECTED TO ST. JOHNS COUNTY AS PART OF ADMINISTRATIVE OR JUDICIAL LITIGATION. THIS RESOLUTION ALSO REPEALS RESOLUTION 96-32.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County that:

1. The County Administrator is authorized, with the advice of the Office of the County Attorney, or other legal counsel representing the County, to answer or respond to, and execute interrogatories submitted to the County as part of administrative or judicial litigation.
2. The County Administrator may delegate authority granted by this resolution to other County employees for particular interrogatories.
3. The County Administrator may, in his or her discretion, bring any particular interrogatory to the Board of County Commissioners for answer or response.
4. St. Johns County Resolution # 96-32 is repealed.
