

RESOLUTION 2001 - 20

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2001 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO RECEIVE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE AND AUTHORIZE ITS EXPENDITURE BY THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT.**

**WHEREAS**, the County operating budget is annually prepared prior to knowing the actual amount of grant funds which may be received by the General Fund; and

**WHEREAS**, St. Johns County, Florida, when preparing the budget for Fiscal Year 2001, did not anticipate receiving grant funds from the State of Florida above and beyond those projected by the Emergency Management Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Florida, Department of Community Affairs has made available from a Legislative Appropriations Act additional grant dollars to renovate the Hastings Community Center for the establishment of a Special Needs Evacuation Center; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Florida has approved additional grant funds to St. Johns County for Fiscal Year 2001 that exceeds budgeted grant amounts by \$250,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Florida has required that those funds be matched by an amount equal to at least a 25% local match; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Hastings, through an interlocal agreement with the County for this purpose, has provided \$83,334, an amount equal to the required 25% local match.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

1. The above "Whereas" statements are adopted as a finding of fact.
2. The General Fund revenue and expenditure budgets shall be adjusted to account for unanticipated funds from the State of Florida in the amount of \$333,334 for Fiscal Year 2000-2001.
