

RESOLUTION 2001 - 22

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT IMPACT FEE RESERVES AND AUTHORIZING ITS USE TO FUND A CAPITAL EQUIPMENT PURCHASE.**

**WHEREAS**, St. Johns County, Florida (the County) has determined that the upgrading of the auxiliary power generator at the County Correctional Facility is in the interest of public safety and welfare; and

**WHEREAS**, the County, in determining of the need for the generator upgrade, found that there is a need for the increased emergency power generation for the Correctional Facility due to an increase in facility use caused by an increased County population; and

**WHEREAS**, the County has enacted an Impact Fee Ordinance to fund or assist in funding the costs of Public Capital Facilities required by population growth; and

**WHEREAS**, the upgrading of the auxiliary power generator at the County Correctional Facility concurs with the Impact Fee Ordinance definition of Public Capital Facilities.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

1. The above "Whereas" statements are adopted as a finding of fact.
2. The FY 2001 Law Enforcement Impact Fee Fund will provide up to \$46,000 as its contribution to the cost of upgrading of the auxiliary power generator at the County Correctional Facility.
