

RESOLUTION 2001 - 239

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING FISCAL YEAR 2001/2002 STATE HOUSING INITIATIVES PARTNERSHIP (SHIP) BUDGET TO RECEIVE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE AND AUTHORIZE ITS EXPENDITURE BY ST. JOHNS COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the County operating budget for its State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) is annually prepared prior to knowing the actual amount of grant funds which may be received by St. Johns County; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County, when preparing the SHIP budget for Fiscal Year 2001/2002, did not anticipate receiving grant funds from the State of Florida above and beyond those projected by the SHIP Program; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida, Department of Community Affairs has made available additional grant dollars through the SHIP Program for Disaster Relief Funding to repair homes damaged during Tropical Storm Gabrielle; and

WHEREAS, this program, will be administered through the SHIP Rehabilitation Program in cooperation with the St. Johns Housing Partnership, Inc.; and


WHEREAS, the State of Florida has grant funds to St. Johns County for Fiscal Year 2001/2002 that exceeds budgeted grant amounts by \$38,400.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:


1. The above recitals are hereby adopted as findings of fact.
2. The State Housing Initiatives Partnership revenue and expenditure budgets shall be adjusted to account for unanticipated funds from the State of Florida in the amount of \$38,400 for Fiscal Year 2001/2002.
