

RESOLUTION 2002 - 49

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2002 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO RECEIVE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE AND AUTHORIZE ITS EXPENDITURE BY THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY FAIR.

WHEREAS, the County operating budget is annually prepared prior to knowing the actual amount of funds which may be received by the General Fund from the sale of County property; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County, Florida, when preparing the budget for Fiscal Year 2002, did not anticipate receiving funds from the State of Florida Department of Transportation above and beyond those projected; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida, Department of Transportation has purchased property from the County for use as right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida, Department of Transportation has purchased land from St. Johns County in Fiscal Year 2002 that exceeded budgeted amounts by \$48,300.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

1. The above "Whereas" statements are adopted as findings of fact.
2. The General Fund revenue and expenditure budgets shall be adjusted to account for unanticipated funds from the State of Florida, Department of Transportation in the amount of \$48,300 for Fiscal Year 2001-2002.
