

RESOLUTION 2002 - 66

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2002 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO RECEIVE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE AND AUTHORIZE ITS EXPENDITURE BY THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY RECREATION DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the County operating budget is annually prepared prior to knowing the actual amount of grant funds which may be received by the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County, Florida, when preparing the budget for Fiscal Year 2002, did not anticipate receiving grant funds from the Florida Inland Navigation District above and beyond those projected by the Recreation Department; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Inland Navigation District has made available additional grant dollars for the Waterfronts Florida program to complete the Vilano ICW Fishing Pier Improvements (the Pavilion) Project at Vilano Beach; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Inland Navigation District has approved additional grant funds to St. Johns County for Fiscal Year 2002 that exceeds budgeted grant amounts by \$107,900.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

1. The above recitals are hereby adopted as findings of fact.
2. The General Fund revenue and expenditure budgets shall be adjusted to account for unanticipated funds from the Florida Inland Navigation District in the amount of \$107,900 for Fiscal Year 2002.
