

RESOLUTION NO. 2002 - 97

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, RECOGNIZING AND APPROPRIATING UNANTICIPATED REVENUE FROM DONATIONS BY MERCHANTS AT THE ST. AUGUSTINE OUTLET CENTER TO ITS FY 2002 FIRE SERVICES BUDGET.**

**WHEREAS**, on November 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>, 2001, over 100 outlet centers all over the nation joined together to recognize the contributions of police, fire and emergency service professionals who serve their communities, and

**WHEREAS**, during that weekend local stores were encouraged to donate 1% of their sales to local agencies, with a match from owner/developers, and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of those sales donations, the St. Augustine Outlet Center presented two checks to the Fire Service totaling \$2223.16, and the Paper Factory store presented a check for \$25.49.

**NOW BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:**

1. The above-recitals are hereby adopted as findings of fact.
2. The Fire Service Fund revenue and expenditure budgets shall be adjusted to account for the receipt of unanticipated revenue in the amount of \$2248.65.
