

RESOLUTION 2003 - 104

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2003 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO RECEIVE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE AND AUTHORIZE ITS EXPENDITURE BY THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the County operating budget is annually prepared prior to knowing the actual amount of grant funds which may be received by the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County, Florida, when preparing the budget for Fiscal Year 2003, did not anticipate receiving grant funds from State of Florida in excess of those projected by the Emergency Management Department by \$1,821; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Administration has provided additional funds to the State of Florida and a portion of these funds have been awarded to the St. Johns County Emergency Management Department for their use.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

1. The above recitals are hereby adopted as legislative findings of fact.
2. The General Fund revenue and expenditure budgets shall be adjusted to account for unanticipated funds from the State of Florida in the amount of \$1,821 for Fiscal Year 2003.
