

RESOLUTION 2003- 20

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN AMENDED REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT RECOGNIZING ADDITIONAL UNANTICIPATED REVENUE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation and St. Johns County desire to facilitate the development of a Corridor Management Plan for the William Bartram Scenic and Historic Highway in St. Johns County; and

WHEREAS, the Corridor Management Plan for the State Road 13 portion of the highway is currently being developed with assistance by the Florida Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the addition of County Road 13 to the Corridor Management Plan is being expedited through a series of meetings and workshops with area residents; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has requested St. Johns County, Florida, to execute and deliver to the State of Florida Department of Transportation an amended Reimbursement Agreement for the aforementioned project to assist in payment for extending the limits of the project for the amount of \$22,195 for a total amount not to exceed \$72,195.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

- 1) The County Administrator is hereby authorized to make, execute and deliver to the State of Florida Department of Transportation the amended Reimbursement Agreement for the aforementioned project; and
- 2) Revenue received by the County pursuant to said Reimbursement Agreement is hereby recognized as unanticipated revenue to the County and such revenue is hereby appropriated and budgeted for the above-described purpose.
