

RESOLUTION 2003 - 34

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2003 TDC CATEGORY III BUDGET TO RECEIVE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE AND AUTHORIZE ITS EXPENDITURE BY THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY RECREATION AND PARKS DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the County budget is annually prepared prior to knowing the actual amount of grant funds which may be received; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County, Florida, when preparing the budget for Fiscal Year 2003, did not anticipate receiving grant funds from the State of Florida above and beyond those projected by the Recreation and Parks Department; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has made available from the Department of Environmental Protection under Amendment No.1 of Contract No. 00SJ1 for the St. Johns County Beach Restoration Project a matching grant; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has approved these funds to be spent on monitoring of the Beach Restoration Project through August 3, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the proposed cost of two year monitoring contract is \$85,339.38; and

WHEREAS, the two year State DEP grant share will be \$42,669.69,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

1. The above recitals are hereby adopted as legislative findings of fact and incorporated herein.
2. The Category III TDC budget shall be adjusted to account for unanticipated funds from the State of Florida in the amount of \$42,669.69 for Fiscal Year 2003.
