

RESOLUTION NO. 2006- 2

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPOINTING THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY DIVISION OF ANIMAL CONTROL AS AGENTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF INVESTIGATING VIOLATIONS OF CHAPTER 828, FLORIDA STATUTES, PERTAINING TO ANIMAL CRUELTY AND RELATED MATTERS.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County, through its Board of County Commissioners, promotes the proper treatment of animals and seeks to curtail and prevent the cruelty of animals; and

WHEREAS, Section 828.03, Florida Statutes, provides that the Board of County Commissioners in any Florida county may appoint one or more agents for the purpose of investigating violations of any of the provisions of Chapter 828, Florida Statutes, pertaining to animal cruelty and related matters; and

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Division of Animal Control is well trained and has extensive experience pertaining to investigations of animal cruelty and animals in distress;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the St. Johns County Division of Animal Control, including each member of the Division certified as an Animal Control Specialist, as certified by the Florida Animal Control Association, are hereby appointed as Animal Cruelty Investigators pursuant to Section 828.03, Florida Statutes, effective this 10th day of January, 2006.
