

RESOLUTION NO. 2006- 301

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, RESTATING THE ADOPTING AND RESTATING THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, PROCEDURES PERTAINING TO THE EMERGENCY CONDITIONS PAY PLAN; REPEALING AND REPLACING RESOLUTION 99-47.

WHEREAS, the event of a major or catastrophic disaster impacting St. Johns County would require the dedication of significantly increased work hours by Fair Labor Standards Act exempt employees in the pre-impact response, recovery and restoration phases; and

WHEREAS, this time spent in disaster related activities would be required despite the high potential for these employees to also be victims of the event; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of public health, safety and welfare to promote emergency availability and compensation in periods of local emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that the Emergency Conditions Pay Plan, as set forth in the St. Johns County Administrative Code at Section 410.3 et. seq., is hereby adopted and incorporated herein as promoting the public health, safety, and welfare interest of the citizens of St. Johns County.

RESOLUTION NO. 99-47 is hereby repealed and replaced, by this **RESOLUTION**.
