

RESOLUTION 2006 - 62

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2006 SOLID WASTE FUND TO RECEIVE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE AND AUTHORIZE ITS EXPENDITURE BY THE SOLID WASTE REFUSE-LANDFILL DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, Pursuant to the Transfer Station and Solid Waste Removal contract Paragraph 2.8, the Contractor is responsible for the appearance and maintenance of the Transfer Station; and

WHEREAS, a Facility Inspection Report conducted by Nelson Engineering Co. identified damages to the Tillman Ridge Transfer Station in the amount of \$45,785.00 from the result of excessive wear and tear by Seaboard Waste Systems; and

WHEREAS, Seaboard Waste Systems has paid \$45,785.00 to the County for these damages; and

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Solid Waste Refuse-Landfill Department needs their recognition as current year revenues to enable the appropriation of these funds for their intended purposes;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

1. The above recitals are hereby adopted as legislative findings of fact.
2. The Solid Waste Fund revenue and the Refuse-Landfill department expenditure budgets shall be adjusted to account for unanticipated funds in the amount of \$45,785 from excessive wear and tear and damages to the Tillman Ridge Transfer Station for Fiscal Year 2006.
