

**Resolution No. 2007-125**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA DECLARING AND FINDING THAT COUNTY EXPENDITURES OF PUBLIC FUNDS FOR THE COUNTY EVENTS, ASSOCIATED WITH THE SELECTION OF THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR SERVE A PARAMOUNT PUBLIC PURPOSE AND SUCH FUNDS MAY LAWFULLY BE USED FOR SUCH PURPOSES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, it is the intent of St. Johns County to promote, protect, and improve the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of St Johns County, Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, the County wishes to use public funds for County events associated with the selection of the County Administrator, which events will serve a paramount public purpose; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The above Recitals are incorporated herein by reference and are hereby adopted as Findings in support of this Resolution.

**Section 2.** It is hereby found, determined and declared that County expenditures of Public Funds for the County events, associated with the selection of the County Administrator serve a paramount public purpose and such funds may lawfully be used for such purposes.

**Section 3.** County staff is hereby authorized and directed to cause the payment for expenditures of Public Funds for County events, associated with the selection of the County Administrator, that serve a paramount public purpose and such funds may lawfully be used for such purposes.

**Section 4.** It is the intent of the Board, and it is hereby provided that if any phrase, clause, sentence, subsection, section or provision of this Resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not be construed as to render invalid or unconstitutional the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, subsections, or provisions of this Resolution.


**Section 5.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
