

RESOLUTION NO. 2008-210

RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA REPEALING AND REPLACING RESOLUTION NO. 96-201, ADOPTING A COUNTY FLAG.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida was granted an official Coat of Arms by the Ministry of Justice by order of His Majesty Juan Carlos, King of Spain on June 2, 1992 as part of the 400th Anniversary of the discovery of the New World; and

WHEREAS, that Coat of Arms has been adopted by the Board of County Commissioners as the official seal of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners wishes to display this official seal in every appropriate manner as a symbol of pride in our history and to identify the origins of the County; and

WHEREAS, one of the ways to do so is to display an official flag;

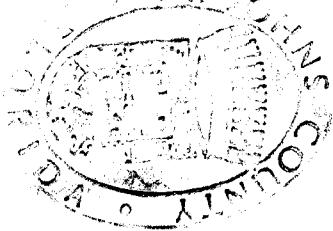
WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution 96-201 in 1996 pertaining to a County flag;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that the flag described as follows is hereby officially adopted:

On a white field, superimposed upon which and centered is the County Logo, displaying the County Seal in the center surrounded by the words "St. Johns County."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that 1) this flag may be properly displayed in County buildings and on all occasions in the same manner and in proper relation to the flag of the State of Florida and 2) this Resolution repeals and replaces Resolution 96-201, effective immediately.
