

RESOLUTION NO. 2010- 285

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, REQUESTING THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE TO APPROVE A LOCAL BILL PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CHAPTER 99-449, LAWS OF FLORIDA AND TRANSFER ALL ASSETS, LIABILITIES AND DUTIES OF THE ANASTASIA MOSQUITO CONTROL DISTRICT TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA.**

**WHEREAS**, on November 2, 2010 the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County voted unanimously to add to the County's Legislative Agenda the consolidation of the Anastasia Mosquito Control District (AMCD) within the management of St. Johns County; and

**WHEREAS**, Florida Statute Section 189.428 establishes an oversight review process for the County to complete in the process of requesting State Legislative action for merger or dissolution of an independent special district such as the AMCD; and

**WHEREAS**, said oversight review process has been completed by the County; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the public interest to provide an opportunity for the taxpayers of St. Johns County to enjoy tax savings through consolidation of services pertaining to mosquito control.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

**Section 1.** The above recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution, and such recitals are adopted as Findings of Fact.

**Section 2.** The Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida requests the Florida Legislature to approve a local bill providing for the repeal of Chapter 99-449, Laws of Florida, and transfer all assets, liabilities and duties of the Anastasia Mosquito Control District to the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County. Should it be determined that the local bill include a referendum component, it is requested that such be included.
